## ORCHESTRA SEATING MAP

This map shows the layout of rows, seats, aisles, entrances, handrails and Access Seating locations on the Orchestra level, Princess of Wales Theatre auditorium. The map is divided into seating zones containing stairs, and accessible seating zones containing no stairs.

## SEATING ZONE WITH NO STAIRS

This zone contains no stairs and no handrails; there is a gradual slope to the floor. Entrances are located on the left and right side of the auditorium next to Row D.

## Rows AA to $\mathbf{G}$ (Left section)

Seats 47 to 35 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, Rows GG to G only, seats 42 to 47 (number varies based on row). Right aisle access, seat 35.

## Rows AA to G (Centre section)

Seats 33 to 18. Left aisle access, seat 33. Right aisle access, seat 18.

## Rows AA to G (Right section)

Seats 16 to 4 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, seat 16. Right aisle access, Rows GG to G only, seats 4 to 9 (number varies based on row).

## Row W

Seat 1 and seats 4 to 6 . These are non-fixed chairs located behind Row U, centre section, and next to the rear auditorium entrances.

## SEATING ZONE WITH STAIRS

This zone contains 14 shallow, wide steps (one per row), with handrails on the outer left and right side walls. Entrances are located at the rear of the auditorium behind the left and right sections of Row $U$.

## Rows H to U (Left section)

Seats 49 to 35 . Left aisle access, seats 47 to 49 (number varies based on row). Right aisle access, seat 35 .

## Rows H to U (Centre section)

Seats 33 to 18. Left aisle access, seat 33. Right aisle access, seat 18.

## Rows H to U (Right section)

Seats 16 to 2. Left aisle access, seat 16 . Right aisle access, seats 2 to 4 (number varies based on row).

## Box A (House Left) and Box B (House Right)

Seats 1 to 4. Boxes are located on the left and right side of the auditorium near the stage. There are 5 stairs, with handrail. Box seats are non-fixed chairs. May be suitable for some guests requiring Special Access seating (not wheelchair accessible).

## Row GG (Right section)

Seats 9 to 11

## Row W (Centre section)

Seat 1 and seats 4 to 6

This map shows the layout of rows, seats, aisles, entrances, handrails and Access Seating locations on the Dress Circle level, Princess of Wales Theatre auditorium. The map is divided into seating zones containing stairs, and accessible seating zones containing no stairs.

## SEATING ZONE WITH NO STAIRS

No stairs required. Entrances are located at the rear of the auditorium behind Row K, left and right sections.

## Row K (Left section)

Seats 56 to 43 . Left aisle access, seat 56.
Right aisle access, seat 43.

## Row K (Centre section)

Seats 37 to 23 . Left aisle access, seat 37 .
Right aisle access, seat 23.

## Row K (Right section)

Seats 18 to 5. Left aisle access, seat 18. Right aisle access, seat 5.

## SEATING ZONE WITH STAIRS

This zone contains 18 stairs (2 per row) with handrails on the outer left and right side aisles, and 12 stairs ( 2 per row) with no handrails on the inner centre aisles. Entrances are located at the left and right side of the auditorium next to Box E and Box H.

## Rows A to C

Seats 54 to 5 (number range varies based on row). These rows have no centre aisles. Left aisle access, seats 53 or 54 (number varies based on row). Right aisle access, seat 5.

## Rows D to J (Left section)

Seats 56 to 41 . Left aisle access, seat 56 . Right aisle access, seat 41.

## Rows D to J (Centre section)

Seats 38 to 23. Left aisle access, seat 38 .
Right aisle access, seat 23.

## Rows D to J (Right section)

Seats 20 to 5 . Left aisle access, seat 20. Right aisle access, seat 5.

Boxes C, D, E and AA (House Left) and Boxes F, G, H and BB (House Right) Boxes are located on the left and right of the auditorium at the base of the stairs, below Row A. Box seats are non-fixed chairs arranged in groupings of 2 to 4 seats (varies based on the Box). May be suitable for some guests requiring Special Access seating (not wheelchair accessible).

## Row K (Centre section)

Seats 23 to 37

## SEATING ZONE WITH NO STAIRS

No stairs required. Entrances are located at the rear of the auditorium behind Row J, left and right sections.

## Row J (Left section)

Seats 55 to 52. Left aisle access only, seat 55.

## Row J (Centre section)

Seats 38 to 23 . Left aisle access, seat 38 . Right aisle access, seat 23 .

## Row J (Right section)

Seats 9 to 6 . Right aisle access only, seat 6 .

## SEATING ZONE WITH STAIRS

This zone contains 24 stairs (3 per row) with handrails on the outer left and right side aisles, and 18 stairs (3 per row) with intermittent handholds on the inner centre aisles. Entrances are located at the left and right side of the auditorium next to Side Seats $A A$ and $B B$, seats 4 to 7 .

## Rows A to B

Seats 57 to 3 (number range varies based on row). These rows have no centre aisles. Left aisle access, Row $A$, seat 56 ; Row $B$, seat 57. Right aisle access, Row A, seat 4; Row B, seat 3.

## Rows $\mathbf{C}$ to H (Left section)

Seats 56 to 41 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, seat 55 or 56 (number varies based on row). Right aisle access, seat 41.

## Rows C to H (Centre section)

Seats 38 to 23 . Left aisle access, seat 38 .
Right aisle access, seat 23.

## Rows C to H (Right section)

Seats 20 to 6 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, seat 20. Right aisle access, seat 5 or 6 (number varies based on row).

## Side Seating AA, 1 to 12 (House Left) and BB, 1 to 12 (House Right)

These seats non-fixed chairs located on the left and right of the auditorium at the base of the stairs, below Row A. They are arranged in groupings as follows: seats 1 to 3 , seats 4 to 7 , seats 8 to 12 . May be suitable for some guests requiring Special Access seating (not wheelchair accessible).

## Row J (Right section)

Seats 6 to 9
