
ORCHESTRA SEATING MAP



ORCHESTRA SEATING MAP

This map shows the layout of rows, seats, aisles, entrances and Access Seating locations on the Orchestra level, Royal Alexandra Theatre auditorium. There are no stairs on this level; all seats are within the accessible seating zone.

The Dress Circle level overhangs the rear portion of the Orchestra level, from Rows G to S.

SEATING ZONE WITH NO STAIRS

There are no stairs and no handrails; there is a gradual slope to the floor. The entrance doors are located at the rear of the auditorium behind the House Centre section.

Rows AA to DD

Seats 29 to 7 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, seats 26 to 29 (number varies based on row). Right aisle access, seat 7. There are no centre aisles.

Rows B to S (House Left section)

Seats 36 to 27 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, seats 30 to 36 (number varies based on row). Right aisle access, seat 27.

Row A (House Centre section)

Seats 25 to 11. Left aisle access, seat 25. Right aisle access, seat 11.

Rows B to R (House Centre section)

Seats 26 to 11. Left aisle access, seat 26. Right aisle access, seat 11.

Rows B to S (House Right section)

Seats 10 to 1 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, seat 10. Right aisle access, seats 1 to 7 (number varies based on row).

Boxes A and B (House Left)

Seats 1 to 4. Non-fixed chairs.

Boxes C and D (House Right)

Seats 1 to 4. Non-fixed chairs.

ACCESS SEATING: Wheelchair accessible, Special Access

Row S (House Right section)

Seats 10 to 2.

Row DD (House Right section)

Seats 10 to 7.

Boxes A and C

Wheelchair accessible seating for up to 2 guests, or Special Access seating for up to 4 guests. Some restrictions may apply.

Boxes B and D

Wheelchair accessible or Special Access seating for up to 4 guests. Some restrictions may apply.

Rows AA to DD

The outside armrest on the left and right aisle seats of these rows lift up to allow for easier transfer into the seat.



DRESS CIRCLE SEATING MAP



DRESS CIRCLE SEATING MAP

This map shows the layout of rows, seats, aisles, handrails and entrances on the Dress Circle level, Royal Alexandra Theatre auditorium. Stairs access is required for all seats on this level.

SEATING ZONE WITH STAIRS

This zone contains stairs with handrails on the outer left and right side aisles, and stairs with no handrails on the inner centre aisles. Entrance doors are located at the rear of the auditorium behind Row J, House Centre section.

Rows A to K (House Left section)

Seats 44 to 32 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, seats 36 to 44 (number varies based on row). Right aisle access, Rows A to H only, seat 32.

There are stairs up to access Row H (1 stair), Row J (2 stairs) and Row K (4 stairs), and stairs down to access Rows A to G (14 stairs in total).

Rows A to J (House Centre section)

Seats 31 to 14 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, seats 31 to 26 (number varies based on row). Right aisle access, seat 14 or 15 (number varies based on row).

There are stairs up to access Row J (3 stairs), and stairs down to access Rows A to G (14 stairs in total).

Rows A to K (House Right section)

Seats 13 to 1 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, Rows A to H only, seat 13. Right aisle access, seats 1 to 9 (number varies based on row).

There are stairs up to access Row H (1 stair), Row J (2 stairs) and Row K (4 stairs), and stairs down to access Rows A to G (14 stairs in total).

Boxes E and F (House Left), and Boxes G and H (House Right)

Boxes are located on the left and right side of the auditorium, below Row A. There are 14 stairs down to access the Boxes, and an additional 3 stairs up to enter Boxes F and H. Box seats are non-fixed chairs. There are 4 seats per Box, seats 1 to 4.



BALCONY SEATING MAP

This map shows the layout of rows, seats, aisles, handrails and entrances on the Balcony level, Royal Alexandra Theatre auditorium. Stairs access is required for all seats on this level.

SEATING ZONE WITH STAIRS

This zone contains stairs with handrails on the outer left and right side aisles, and on the inner centre aisles. Entrance doors are located at the rear of the auditorium behind Row H, House Centre section.

Rows A to J (House Left section)

Seats 46 to 37 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, Rows E to J only, seats 37 to 42 (number varies based on row). Right aisle access, Rows A to G only, seat 34.

There are stairs up to access Row H (3 stairs) and Row J (5 stairs), and stairs down to access Rows A to G (26 stairs in total).

Rows A to G (House Centre section)

Seats 33 to 14 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, seat 33 to 28 (number varies based on row). Right aisle access, seat 14.

There are stairs down to access Rows A to G (26 stairs in total).

Row H (House Centre section)

Seats 33 to 30. Aisle access, seat 30. Seats 17 to 14. Aisle access, seat 14.

There are 2 stairs up to access Row H.

Rows A to J (House Right section)

Seats 13 to 1 (number range varies based on row). Left aisle access, Rows A to G only, seat 13. Right aisle access, Rows E to J only, seats 5 to 10 (number varies based on row).

There are stairs up to access Row H (3) and Row J (5), and stairs down to access Rows A to G (26 in total).
